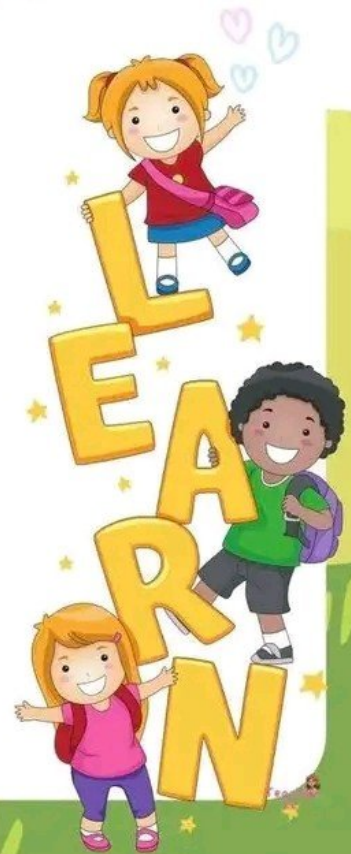

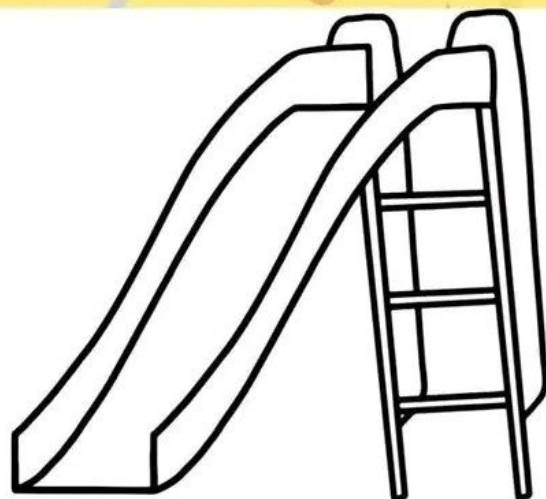




At night, the room is dark.

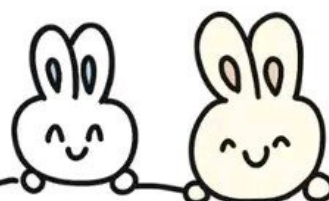

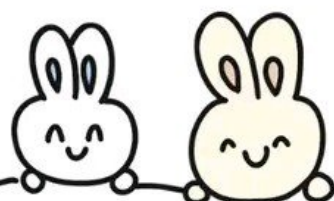
Birds Are Amazing

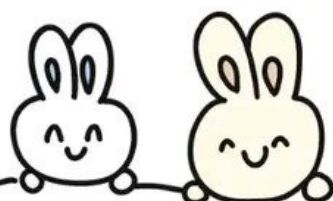

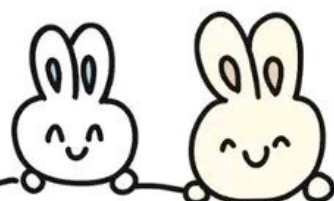
